

**Williams Act - Sufficiency of Instructional Materials  
Resolution # 7 - 2014/2015**

**WHEREAS**, the governing board of Novato Unified School District in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on October 7, 2014, at 6:30 o'clock, which is on or before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

**WHEREAS**, the governing board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

**WHEREAS**, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

**WHEREAS**, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the district, and;

**WHEREAS**, the definition of sufficient textbooks or instructional materials; means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

**WHEREAS**, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of curriculum frameworks in the following subjects.

- English/Language arts, including the English Language Development component of an adopted program
- Mathematics
- Science
- History-Social Science

**WHEREAS**, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or health classes, and;


**WHEREAS**, laboratory science equipment was available for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12, inclusive;

**THEREFORE**, it is resolved that for the 2014-2015 school year, the Novato Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
