Process Timeline

October (Today)

- Establish Norms and Meeting Guidelines
- Driving Question: Defining the Task "The What"
- Objective: Describe what's going on from their perspective, let's understand the situation and what needs to be resolved before moving to interests and options/solutions

November 3rd

- Identify Interests "The Why"
- Begin to look at Options/Solutions "The How"
 - Data is helpful to generate options
 - Look at what working groups bring back from research

December 1st

- Begin to Evaluate all the options (One option is keep school schedules as they are)
- Begin to Reach Consensus and Commit to Agreements

January 19th

- Continue to Evaluate all the options
- Continue to Reach Consensus and Commit to Agreements
- Get feedback from stakeholders

February 16th

- Develop and recommend a plan for implementation
- Present plan(s) to different stakeholders

March 16th

- Finalize draft plan(s)
- Present draft plan to Board as a presentation on March 21st

March / April

• Negotiations with Union(s) if Needed

May 2nd

• Present final plan with recommendations to Board pending negotiations if needed
